



Encompass Support Services Society (ESSS) is a grassroots, non-profit agency that provides enriching and essential programs and support services in Langley, British Columbia. As a leading social service organization, Encompass offers a variety of free and inclusive programs for children and families with a focus on building a strong, sustainable community. ESSS bridges significant gaps with life-changing initiatives such as parent support groups, after school programs, counselling services and Bridges to Employment.

Encompass has a long-standing history of serving its community and recently celebrated its 25th anniversary this past Fall. In 2020, they supported 2500+ individuals in the City of Langley, Township of Langley and Aldergrove area

through their nine support sites and outreach partners.
